Funerals where possible should be held in the church facilities itself as further testimony to the person's Christian faith.

But most importantly the service is to be planned and conducted in such a manner as to testify to your salvation in Jesus Christ alone. The funeral service at its best delivers Christ through the Word, liturgy and hymns to the congregation assembled. For many in the congregation this will be the first or best opportunity they have to receive the proclamation of salvation through Christ by faith through grace alone. For those who are already Christian it will be a further strengthening of their faith.
